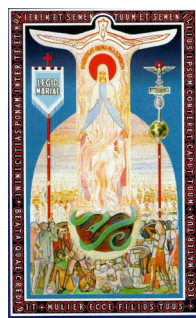

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend, Our Lord gives us an incredible exposition on grace and how we must cooperate with God for our salvation. God is always and everywhere offering us graces for this purpose. It may not “feel like it,” but that’s the point of the parable of the soil. If our soul is rocky and we are habituated in a life of sin, it will be more difficult for us to cooperate when offered an opportunity. If we mistake God’s grace for our own enthusiasm and the plant springs up, the sun will scorch it. If God’s grace is planted amongst thorns and thistle in our hearts, it will be choked by our own desire to hold onto our former way of life. If we constantly seek to prepare our soul by cooperating with the grace of God in the life of virtue, God will cause us to turn towards Him and produce spiritual fruit. We till the soil with a life of prayer, of frequenting the sacraments, we refresh ourselves with a life of devotion and pray the Rosary daily. When we are tempted, when we are tried, the flower will not scorch nor be choked, but will grow having been watered by the grace of God.
