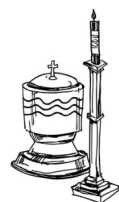

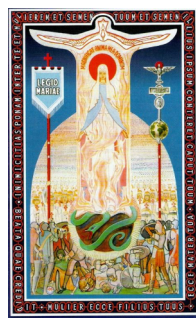

Sly was an Anglican archbishop that was ordained a Catholic priest under the pastoral provision and is now a member of the Ordinariate of the Chair of St. Peter (a sort of diocese spread out over North America with churches in various locales for Anglicans who have joined the Catholic Church and desire to still live part of their English and Anglican liturgical patrimony and customs). Fr. Sly is also assigned to St. Therese North in Parkville as an associate pastor and celebrates the Roman Rite on a regular basis there. He was also the past-president of St. Michael the Archangel High School. Please welcome him to St. Ann.
