

Dear Friends in Christ,

We find Our Lord today in Gentile territory and we learn that it is Faith, in this case, that heals the Canaanite woman. Is Faith, in this case, an

impassioned plea to have her daughter healed? What sort of Faith does she have? In Jesus, the woman recognizes and confesses His Divinity. It is not merely a request, however valid that may be, for the healing of her daughter. Rather, it is a recognition of His omnipotence and power over demons. Only God has this power. And implicitly, she responded to the grace of God for the virtue of Faith to develop in her soul and have the ability to confess this. God moves even the most intransigent of us to conversion. It was possible for this woman whom Jesus did not immediately answer or give her what she wanted. Rather, He was looking for something deeper in her. A recognition of a truth. She would have to renounce and give up her own ways, her own false worship.
