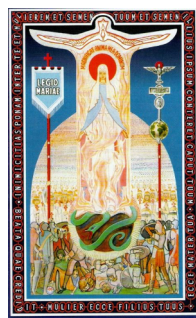

*Dear Friends in Christ,*

This weekend, we welcome Fr. Thulani Gubula from the Diocese of Queenstown, South Africa for our annual missionary Sunday. Please give him a warm welcome!

In today’s Gospel, we witness a foreshadowing of the Church with the interaction between St. Peter and the Lord Himself. As they are walking in pagan territory in Caesarea Philippi, they walk past what is considered Hades or the gateway to the underworld in mythology. To say that the gates of hell will not prevail against the Church is no understatement as they have this conversation. Our Lord gives the authority to bind and loose to the Apostle St. Peter and builds the Church upon this office. He does not build it upon the man himself, but upon the office He establishes. It is to be a principal of unity for the visible Church until the end of time. Yet, this office is based on Peter’s confession that Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah who has come into the world. The office of Peter, therefore, is to guard this same faith in Christ Jesus along with the other Apostles. The Church is visible because God became man. The Church is the Mystical Body of Christ. The Church and Christ are inseparable because the Bridegroom is never separated from His Bride.

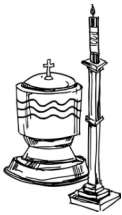
