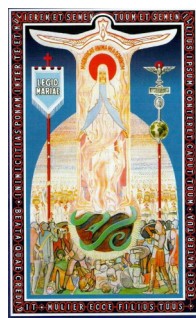

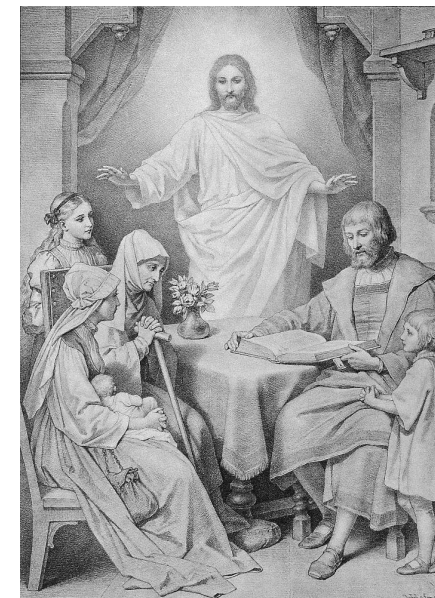

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Lord’s words in today’s Gospel are important for our interaction with one another as Christians. In places of business, schools, churches, this is the thing that most of violate the most. Many are tempted to go right to the top and instead of going to the person with whom we have an issue or who has offended us, we tell everyone else. The Lord is not referring to petty things here either that just annoy us, but real wrongs that people commit. We’ve all seen it go the other way as well—where some can appoint themselves as “rule keepers” or correctors. The Lord lays out a clear way of handling conflict when it comes to offense. If we are able, we should go to the offender first and explain our issue. If that doesn’t work and it is still bad behavior, we should bring another person. Then, the Lord says to “tell the Church.” This is kind of the process for dealing with notorious sinners or those of a heretical bent. A personal admonishment, perhaps another warning, and then finally perhaps a medicinal penalty. Even in the time the Gospel was written, it was a temptation to immediately jump to step three and apply a punitive penalty immediately. Our Lord says, we must follow the first two steps first. It is so easy to “kick our problems” upstairs for someone to fix. The Lord challenges us today to confront the issues we have with justice and with mercy.
