Dear Friends In Christ-

This week in September marks a littleknown changing point in the liturgical year. There was a medieval rhyme that went something like this: Lenty, Penty, Crucy, Lucy. It was a pneumatic device used to remember when the Ember Days took place. Ember Days (Wednesday, Friday and a Saturday) were days of fasting and abstinence that took place with the change of each season to not only give thanks for the

previous harvest, but also to pray and fast for the clergy of the Church. Ember Saturdays were days in which traditionally priestly ordinations took place. It was an event that was joyful, but one that began in penance in thanksgiving to God.

This week, on Wednesday, is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. According to the rhyme above, next Wednesday would be one of these days of fasting and abstinence. This Feast commemorates the raising of the piece of the Cross of the Lord, found by St. Helena in the 4th century, to be enshrined properly in the City of Jerusalem for all to publically venerate. May 3rd was formerly the day in which we celebrated her finding it miraculously, September commemorated when it was venerated. In between, the faithful had the possibility of being blessed with the relic to ask God to prevent dangerous weather and storms during the summer months and to protect the crops. As we give thanks to God for His many gifts, let us remember it is the glorious cross in which we find our salvation.
