

Dear Friends in Christ,

This last week, we celebrated both the Exaltation of the Holy Cross and the Feast of the Seven Sorrows of the Blessed Virgin Mary, September 14th and September 15th, respectively. I have spoken about this before, but I

think it is worth mentioning again for the sake of our spiritually, which in the case of our parish, is still agrarian in many ways. The week after September 14th on the Wednesday, Friday and Saturday were, for many centuries since the at least the time of St. Leo the Great, considered Ember Days in the Roman Church. These were days to not only fast and abstain from meat, but also to give the thanks to God for the bounty of the earth that He has provided for us. They were also days to pray especially for the clergy of our church and to ordain new clergy. Penitential in nature, they remind us of the changing of the season. They are yet another time to pause and reflect on the mystery of God's Providence. While they are no longer in the Roman Calendar, although some dioceses have instituted them again in the United States, we can live this spiritually on our own, in our families. That is give thanks to God for His goodness toward us and also let us pray especially for our Holy Father, our bishop, and the many priests in our diocese.
