Dear Friends In Christ-

Making friends with dishonest wealth is one of the more perplexing of the pericopes in the Gospel of Luke. Yet, frankly, it simply means that if we cannot be trusted with small, worldly things that do not have a big spiritual value, then how can we be trusted with more serious decisions that affect our position in eternity? In other words, we cannot be expected to be honest all of the sudden one day on a big decision if we’ve habituated ourselves to lie in small things

or to commit small lesser sins of theft, even if not gravely immoral. The moral life is built on smaller things first that are not as grave as to create a good habit, also called a virtue. When we possess a particular virtue, it is a sort of freedom where we do not even have to consider much what is right and what is wrong—we are habituated in our memory and our will to simply choosing the good. This comes from repeating things over and over. In the supernatural world in which God gives a particular grace for a supernatural end (heaven) and not just being naturally good, He builds upon the foundation we have already laid by cooperating with Him in small matters. Indeed, being honest in lesser things prepares us to make ultimate moral decisions that will determine our salvation.

As I explained last week, the traditional Ember Days of September are this Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. They are no longer obligatory, but in the spirit of penance and thanksgiving to the Lord for His blessings upon us, let us fast and abstain (Friday) together for the Church.
