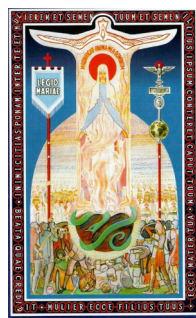

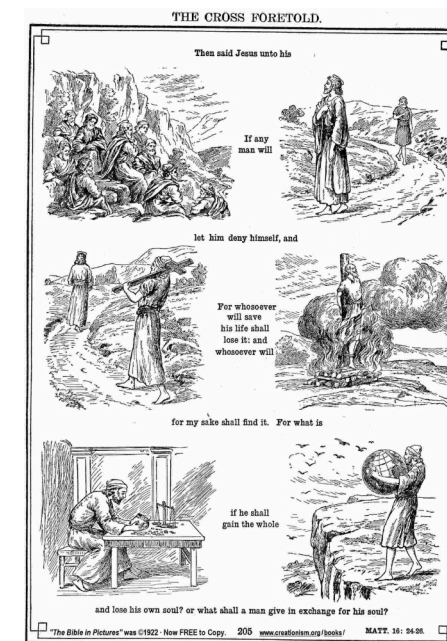

Dear Friends in Christ,

Our Lord presents to us today the ultimate Christian paradox of what it means to follow Him. The Lord must die in order to give us life. Whoever takes up his cross and follows the Lord also follows in these same footsteps.

To the twenty-first century individualist, this dying to oneself must seem so foreign. It denies the fundamental principle of individualism—there is nothing outside oneself, no community-oriented goal, no salvific goal, only a loosely-based self-improvement not based on good or evil or overcoming oneself selfishness, but simply a giving in to “one’s truth,” even if it is at the expense of others. Whereas Jesus Christ asks us to deny our very lives, if need be to follow Him, in an ultimately witness of a union that goes beyond ourselves, the demons of the age simply suggest that we do something fully and solely self-gratifying for ultimate fulfillment, which, by the way, is not to be found anywhere else except for in one’s internal self-justification with one’s behavior. Radically different is the call that Jesus gives Peter—to be a Christian is to constantly die to oneself for another. To overcome even one’s love to live if it means we lay down this life for another. The meaning of humanity for a Christian is to become like the Master, like the Savior, who gives His life for the many.
