DEAR FRIENDS IN CHRIST,

There are so many quote unquote types of acceptable relationships today in our society. The more advanced that the society gets, the more comfortable society gets, and the comfortable society gets, the more morally lax it becomes.

While everyone yearns for relationship in his/her life, Jesus lays down the true meaning of Genesis—marriage is the primordial sacrament or sign.
