Happy Easter! At the greatest Christian feast day of the year, we begin our celebration of joy of the Lord’s Resurrection from the dead knowing and believing that the tomb is truly empty. Jesus Christ has destroyed sin, death and the devil. And for this, after a hopefully penitential Lent, we are re-ordered to be like Him.

The Resurrection of Christ is a new Genesis, a new beginning. If we have taken on extra penances, if we have been serious about Lent, then we will now experience a foretaste of freedom. A foretaste of the sort of freedom that we will receive in the Last Judgment and our glorious resurrection. Next Sunday, after the 10:00am Mass, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, and Benediction.
