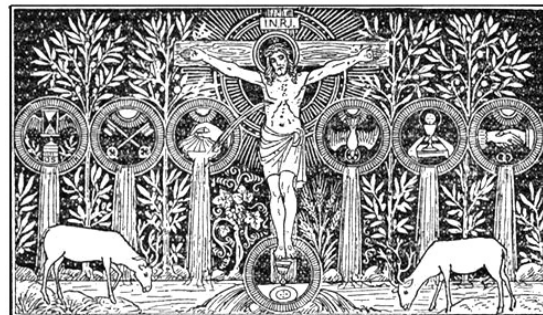

Dear Friends In Christ-

When St. John peers into the tomb on Easter Sunday, he “sees and believes.” The Risen Lord appears to His Apostles, the doors locked, on Easter Sunday evening. Thomas is not present and doesn’t believe, even with the testimony of the other Apostles, that the Lord has truly risen in glory. When He puts his finger into the glorified wound of the Lord, he believes. Our Lord admonishes him: “Blessed are those who have not seen and believe.” We can often make our own intellect the full modicum of truth when in reality, the truth of the matter is outside of us. It is our intellects that correspond to what we see and verify it. Yet, we are verifying something outside of us that already exists independent of us in ourselves. Thomas lacked Faith—he didn’t assent to the truth of the resurrection until he could verify it with his own hand. He distrusted his brother apostles and their testimony. As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday or Low Sunday, we are given a glimpse of the Risen Lord under the appearances of bread and wine. With supernatural Faith, we say the same as St. Thomas did—“My Lord and My God!”

Today, after the 10:00AM Sunday Mass, we will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet together in front of the Exposed Blessed Sacrament and finish with Benediction. There is a plenary indulgence attached to this devotion under the usual conditions.

Next weekend, Sunday, May 1st, at the 10:00AM Mass, several of our youngest members will receive their First Holy Communion and the image of Our Lady of Fatima will be crowned for the month of May. After Mass, the children will receive the Brown Scapular and we will process around the church building with the statue of Our Lady.
