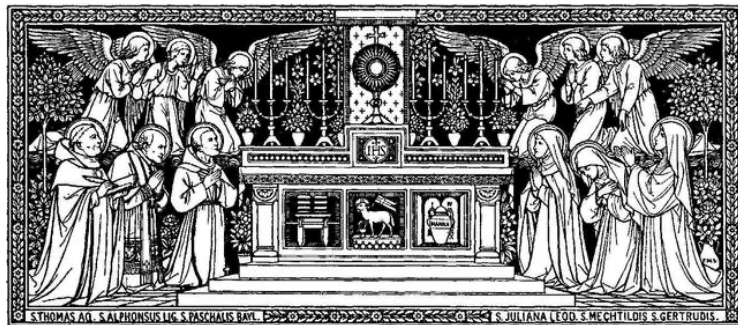

Dear Friends In Christ-

On this Third Sunday of Easter, we find the Risen Lord at the Sea of Tiberius mysteriously appearing to speak with His Apostles. Perhaps St. John says it best in the midst of confusion because he intuitively clearly that this is the voice of Jesus when he says “It is the Lord.” In kind of a continuation of St. John’s narration of he and Peter finding the empty tomb, John sees and believes first in the resurrection, but allows Peter to enter into the empty tomb first. John recognizes the glory of the Risen Lord by His voice, but Peter is the one to jump into the sea and swim ashore to meet Him.

It is at the Sea of Tiberius that Peter is forgiven for his denial of the Lord during His Passion. It is here where the Lord announces what sort of death Peter will experience by following Christ. For those of us who follow the Lord, we are often led where we do not want to go. Yet, by following Christ, we will be fed not only here on this earth by His Risen Body and Blood, but also in the life to come.

A congratulations to our First Communicants and their families on this very special weekend where they receive the Body and Blood of the Lord for the first time. What a joy-filled and special event as they grow in faith. Thank you to the teachers and parents who prepared them and for those who prepared today for our Marian procession after the 10:00am Mass.
