

THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

The Domestic Church Movement provides formation using the Church’s spiritual tradition and official teachings, for how to pray, how to use Scripture in prayer, and how to grow in a real relationship with God, our spouses, and our children in light of our baptism. It began under the leadership of Fr. Franciszek Blachnicki, a close collaborator with Pope St. John Paul II who was the Archbishop who oversaw the founding of this movement in Poland in 1973.


During the Light-Life married couples retreat, couples are invited to dedicate their faith life and marriage more fully to God and His good plan for their marriage and they are introduced to the basics of the 7 commitments that make up the “method” for the Domestic Church movement.
